## 1 Registration Online

Welcome to the 2025 Winter netball season at Palmyra Rebels Netball Club (PRNC or the Club).

This pack contains important information regarding the upcoming season.

Fremantle Netball Association (FNA) will, by directive from Netball WA, be continuing with a Modified Competition in line with the Net Set Go program of Netball Australia. Net Set Go is for all players in 8 & Under, 9 & Under and 10 & Under.

For ALL players born 2015 – 2018 you will need to register through **NET SET GO** registration link.

### **Please note:**

All on-line registrations must be accompanied with either full payment, vouchers or alternatively pay using PayPal "Pay in 4". If you are financial – you are covered by insurance in the case of an injury whilst at training. If you are **NOT** financial, you are **NOT** covered.

Once age groups are at capacity of teams of 10 athletes, late registrations will be placed on a waiting list for team selection, in which case no guarantee of team placement can be made for you/your child/ren.

Before completing the PRNC player on-line registration process through PlayHQ, please read the terms and conditions carefully, particularly those regarding your Umpiring costs and expectations and your obligations to the Club.

## 2 Registration Information

When registering with PRNC, you (the player and if the player is under 18 years old, the first named parent/legal guardian), understands and agrees as follows;

- 2.1 **Players will be graded into teams in accordance with Club Grading policy which can be found on our website [www.prnc.com.au](http://www.prnc.com.au)**
- 2.2 **PRNC adopts and endorses all of Netball WA and Fremantle Netball Associations (FNA) Codes of Conduct and Policies. Therefore, you are agreeing to abide by these codes, as well as other rules, policies and regulations established by Netball WA and FNA which can be found on their websites:**

- 2.3 **I give permission for my or my child's/childrens details to be used for all administrative tasks within the Club, including sharing of contact details with Coaches, Team Managers and other Club officials.**
- 2.4 **If I am a new player and younger than 18, then I (or my parent/legal guardian) may be asked to produce appropriate proof of my age to a PRNC official when grading commences.**

### MEDICAL ATTENTION:

Please ensure that the Grading Coordinator, Coach and Team Manager are notified of any conditions, medical or otherwise, prior to the start of season.

- Should any injury occur during a game at FNA, you're required to go to the first aid room to lodge a Record of Injury for insurance purposes. If you are injured at training, please advise the Coach or Team Manager immediately so an insurance claim can be lodged via an Incident Report Form located on the PRNC Equipment Cage door.

- 4.4 All registrations must be accompanied by full payment unless otherwise arranged with PRNC Registrar.
- 4.5 Late registrations including returning members who have not registered in time will be placed on a wait list for team selection, no guarantee of team placement can be made for you/your child/children.



## 5 Withdrawing Registration

Should you need to withdraw your registration, prior to grading commencing, please inform PRNC Registrar [registrar@prnc.com.au](mailto:registrar@prnc.com.au) in writing along with your request for a refund.

## 6 Grading Process

The PRNC grading process involves:

1. Pre-season player assessment/trials which will be held over 3 sessions and are compulsory, being:

**Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> February**

2. Coaches assessment of player performance within their own team from the previous season, this also includes the athlete's skills, attendance, effort and attitude.

**Grading is based on year of birth, not school year, as per FNA requirements.**

The grades/divisions for 2025 will be:

- Open - 2006 or older
  - 18 & Under – 2007, 2008
  - 16 & Under - 2009
  - 15 & Under - 2010
  - 14 & Under - 2011
  - 13 & Under - 2012
  - 12 & Under - 2013
  - 11 & Under - 2014
  - 10 & Under Go - 2015
  - 9 & Under Go - 2016
  - 8 & Under Set - 2017, 2018
- Participation at the Club's grading trials is compulsory unless there are special extenuating circumstances. Any absence must be communicated in writing to the Grading Coordinator [grading@prnc.com.au](mailto:grading@prnc.com.au) **PRIOR** to the commencement of trials. Please note that absences may be taken into account when team placement is considered.
- Every endeavour is made by the Grading Committee to place members appropriately in teams taking into consideration skills and team balance. We cannot guarantee to place your child/ren with their friend/s.
- If you choose to withdraw your child/ren from PRNC once registration and grading has occurred, a portion, or all, of fees is non-refundable.
- Once a player is graded and the teams announced, the Club's policy is not to move that player to another team, other than exceptional circumstances (eg where a player is seriously injured and this necessitates another player to be moved).
- All teams are submitted to FNA with PRNC's grading request. The grade of the team is then decided upon by the FNA grading committee.

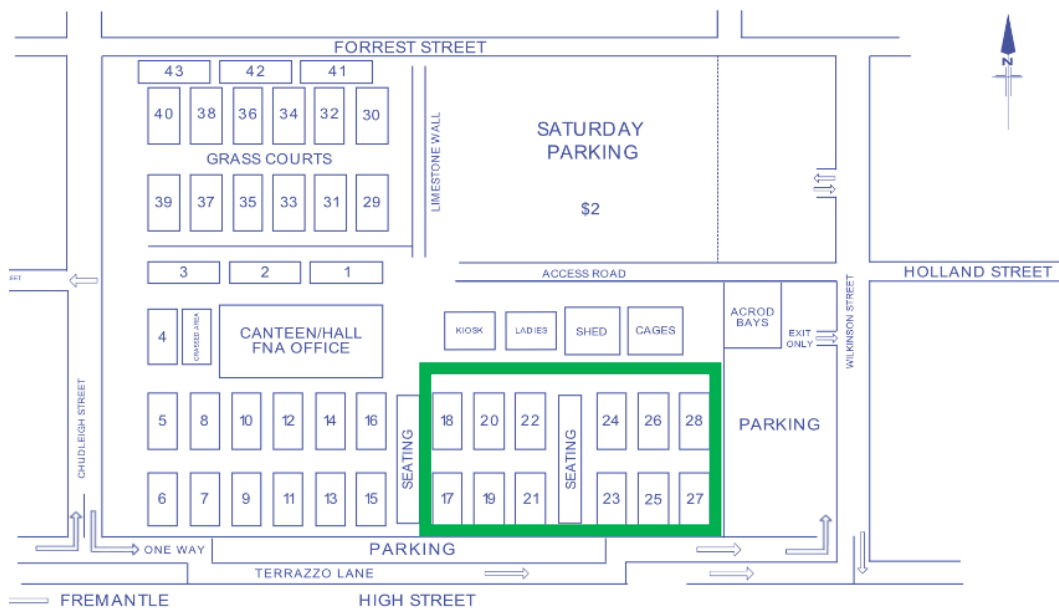

**7 Training Details for 2025**

Training will be held every **Wednesday afternoon/evenings** at Frank Gibson Park (FNA playing courts). Coaches and players will be advised of their times and court allocations after the final grading session. Training will commence the week following the final grading session and training times for 2025 will continue at the same time each week for the duration of the season, unless notified by the Coach.

Please note – due to limited courts, training times may slightly differ to grading times.

## 12 Umpiring

**An Umpiring Information and Education Session will be held on a date TBC for ALL players in 14/U age group.**

For every team that PRNC registers in the 2025 playing season, the Club is required by FNA to supply an Umpire. Therefore, all players from 14 years old and onwards will be allocated **Club umpiring duties** throughout the playing season to cover these requirements. If you are playing in the Open grades then you will be allocated to Open duties and Juniors will be allocated to Junior games

Open and 18/U players do have the opportunity to pay an 'Umpiring Levy' when registering. This levy will remove your name from the Umpiring rostering fixture and the club will sort umpires. Based on the 2024 season team numbers dependent Open and 18's will have a minimum 3 rostered duties throughout this season.

The Club will be running in-house umpiring courses prior to the 2025 season commencing for all players starting at an introductory level. FNA offer many valuable Umpiring workshops throughout the year – it would be highly recommended that all Umpires, especially on The PRNC Umpiring Development Squad (RUDS) attend these workshops.



PRNC will also be continuing their Mentoring program in 2025. This program aims to provide more support for Club Umpires and development for Umpires wishing to extend their umpiring experience and qualifications further.

**Please note that if PRNC contributes to the cost of your umpiring education, then there is a reasonable expectation by the Club that you will give PRNC your 1<sup>st</sup> priority to umpire for us when you are available to umpire during the season.**

**Failure to Umpire** – FNA imposes a \$100 fine per duty to the club along with a team penalty of 2 premiership points deducted. The fine will be passed onto the rostered Umpire as well as a further \$45 to pay the substitute Umpire - totalling \$145. If you incur a fine you will be unable to play until it is paid.

### **RUDS - REBELS UMPIRING DEVELOPMENT SQUAD**

RUDS has been developed to promote and encourage umpiring within our Club. The RUDS is structured to allow athletes 14 years and older to develop confidence umpiring Club games whilst being mentored by a fellow Club member.

If an athlete would like to join the RUDS – they will be **expected** to complete the following umpiring courses prior to the season beginning;

### RUDS Mentor

It is a prerequisite that a RUDS Mentor has achieved their National C Badge. It will be expected that Mentors are also continuing their Umpiring Development. Mentors will also receive education to upskill their Mentoring Skills.
